
Background

This project aims at deploying a certified Safe and Secure truck Parking Area with **70 truck parking spaces** according to the requirements of the gold level of the EU-Parking Standard.

The project will contribute to improve and further increase the security of the Romanian transport infrastructure by developing a safe and secure parking area, in which trucks will have access to adequate parking spaces combined with service facilities. The mandatory service facilities under the EU-Parking Standard will be provided along with some of the optional service facilities under the EU-Parking Standard, such as the laundry services and the resting area.

The location of the project is situated in **Strejnicu**, a rural area, west of the city of Ploiesti in the southern part of Romania, along the Rhine–Danube Corridor between DN1/E80 and DJ129. The safe and secure truck parking area has a significant role with regard to the national and international freight volumes in the region.

The project will be completed in the first quarter of 2023 and we invite you to join us in the kick-off event to show you our plans and discuss the steps ahead with you.
